A few items have been noted that need attention on the new construction of Rizzolo's house. The Board will ask the ARC committee to review the final construction and will write a letter to address to Mr. Rizzolo and to Diamond Construction.

Maintenance

Planting in the island will be postponed in the rainy season begins.

The culverts at on the lake side are overgrown. There is budget money for lake maintenance, Alex and Mario will be notified.

Road, swales, and flumes

Alex and Mario have cut a swale ditch at the Esposito and Flishen. The swale project will be tabled until we see how the new road and flumes perform during the rainy season
